



Berry: Well the Grooms responsibility is to the ponies and the stalls.


Alexis: I've never noticed any stalls in need of cleaning, so I assumed that someone else was cleaning them. *smiles sweetly*

The other cool thing I neglected to mention is that it is by the sea so it comes with - *included in the rental fee* - a sea view. So combine that with the massive light on top - *also included in the rental fee* - you can enjoy the sea view all 24 hours!

The lighthouse tower has five floors, each of which is dominated by a spiral staircase snaking up to the top of the structure. Given each floor is round in shape, it provides some brilliant and unique layout possibilities for budding home designers, although probably involving a lot of round furniture.

A more traditionally rectangle shaped ground floor area provides a well lit living space and connects through to the base of the spiral staircase without having to go outside.

But don't just take my word for it, it also features a genuine Rebel[™] graffiti symbol marking it as a property of note.


